**Re: Pay and Conditions Claim for 2014/15**

Following my letter of 23 December 2014 and our WJNC(FE) Officer's Meeting yesterday, I am writing on behalf of the Board of Colegau Cymru to formally revise our response to the Joint Trade Unions pay and conditions claim for 2014/15.

The Board agreed that our overriding priority must now be to bring all parties together to work to make the case for the best possible settlement for further education in 2015/16 and 2016/17. To this end, the Board has agreed a revised pay offer for a 1% pay uplift for staff in 2014/15. This is a recommendation from the Board of Colegau Cymru to the governing bodies of colleges who have the formal power to approve a pay award.
