

Precarious work in higher education – update August 2022

This short report provides an update to some of the key data contained in our 'Precarious Work in Higher Education' report (see work-in-higher-education-Oct-21/pdf/UCU_precarity-in-HE_Oct21.pdf).

The updated data is taken from the HESA staff data 2020/21, the most recent data we have access to at the time of writing.

All the table numbers refer to the tables in the original report.

All numbers are rounded to the nearest 5, any calculations are made before rounding and all percentages are shown as whole numbers.

There have been some changes but there has been no significant reduction in the levels of casualisation in the sector nor changes in the disparity in the levels of casualisation between men and women and BAME and white academic staff.

T = Teaching only
