WHY ARE WE STRIKING?

PAY - WE NEED TO CLOSE THE GAP

There is a recruitment and retention crisis in further education, and closing the pay gap between schools and colleges is crucial. The gap makes it difficult for colleges to attract and retain quality teachers and support staff.

All additional funding in FE must be ring-fenced for staff pay.

- Pay in the sector has fallen in real terms by more than 40% since 2009/10.
- There should be **minimum guaranteed starting salaries** for teachers in FE.
- There should be **national pay spines** with progression and headroom.

WORKLOAD - WE NEED TO AGREE MAXIMUM HOURS

The lack of effective national agreements on working hours and planning, preparation and assessment (PPA) time are the root cause of excessive and unhealthy workloads.

In the next three years there will be 60,000 more students entering FE yet 50% of lecturing staff leave within the first three years.

We need:

- **maximum weekly and annual teaching hours, and evening and weekend work**
- **agreement on the definition of a *teaching hour***
- **more support staff**
- **nationally-agreed class sizes**
- **national policy on the delivery of guided learning hours**
- **boundaries for contacting staff by email or phone.**

NATIONAL BARGAINING - WE NEED FULLY FUNDED AGREEMENTS

We need meaningful national bargaining with binding outcomes and a new national agreement to make effective use of resources.

Support our strike for:

- **a 10% pay increase**
- **meaningful action on workload**
- **fully-funded and binding national bargaining in FE.**
