

Suggested questions for your Welsh Assembly candidates 2016

1. How will your party seek to monitor and review the mechanisms for determining the pay of senior managers both in Further and Higher Education, and seek to improve the transparency and accountability of post compulsory education institutions in Wales?
2. The Hazelkorn review of the oversight of post compulsory education in Wales, recommended the establishment of a single new regulatory, oversight and co-ordinating authority for the post compulsory sector; how will your party seek to implement this recommendation?
3. How will your party seek to protect Adult Education and enhance the provision of lifelong learning in Wales?
4. How will your party seek to ensure that all Universities in Wales receive funding that allows them to undertake world class research and deliver high quality, highly respected Higher Education that will benefit both the economy and the students of Wales?
5. How will your party seek to ensure that they meaningfully engage teaching practitioners in the post 16 sector, in future policy decisions affecting that sector, for example the new framework for Initial Teacher Education and Training, or the proposals for Continuous Professional Development?
6. What does your party see as the role for Further Education in the development of the new curriculum, as a result of Professor Graham Donaldson's report 'Successful Futures'?
