Cynhaliwyd arolwg gan Gyngor y Gweithlu Addysg ar ran Llywodraeth Cymru rhwng 31 Hydref 2016 a 9 Ionawr 2017. Lluniwyd cwestiynau a dyluniad yr arolwg gan Gyngor y Gweithlu Addysg mewn cydweithrediad â swyddogion Llywodraeth Cymru, gyda mewnbwn gan nifer o undebau llafur.

Roedd y canfyddiadau allweddol i ddarlithwyr ym maes AB fel a ganlyn:

National Education Workforce Survey

The survey was carried out by the Education Workforce Council (EWC) on behalf of the Welsh Government between 31 October 2016 and 9 January 2017. The questions and design of the survey were produced by the EWC in collaboration with Welsh Government officials, with input from a number of trade unions.

All EWC registrants were invited to complete online questionnaires.

Key findings for lecturers in FE were:

92.3% considered the most rewarding part of their role was 'teaching and seeing learners progress'

Administration (69.1%) and workload (61.8%) were seen as the least rewarding.

Hazelkorn

The framework for building a world-class post-compulsory education system

By Professor Ellen Hazelkorn was commissioned by Welsh Government to examine issues such as the growing complexity, duplication and provision gaps across post-compulsory education and training. It considered how to better align governance and funding arrangements, ensuring a learner focused system that enhances educational and career opportunities. A white Paper is due to be published shortly.

Support funding for students resident in Wales – Diamond

UCU Wales submitted a **response** to the Welsh Government consultation on

Initial Teacher Training and Education

In March Kirsty Williams **announced** changes for initial teacher education in Wales.

All programmes of Initial Teacher Education (ITE) in Wales which commence from September 2019 must first be accredited by the Education Workforce Council (EWC), through its ITE Accreditation Board.

The process for Partnerships to prepare and submit programmes to the EWC formally opened in March 2017.
