Anti-union tactics

Staff at CU Group, a subsidiary company of Coventry University have been subjected to disgraceful union busting behaviour from their employer.

These staff teach on university degree programmes, just like other university teachers, but they are paid less, they don't have a proper pension scheme and they teach long hours without the time to rest or prepare their courses properly.

These staff need and want a union to represent them. An overwhelming majority have said that they want UCU, the University and College Union, to represent them.

On 8 March, these staff discovered that unknown to them, their employer had registered a staff consultative forum as a sham union and signed a recognition agreement with it with the aim of stopping UCU from applying for legal recognition.

Staff want an independent union

Staff are furious and want an independent union. CU Group has said it might recognise UCU but not for proper negotiations on pay and other key conditions.

This behaviour shames Coventry University.

10,000 academics have signed a petition of protest

24 MPs have signed a motion in Parliament condemning Coventry University.

On 16 May we will be lobbying the University's Board of Governors. Join the protests and send a message to Coventry University.
