

Disabled people aged 16-18 were at least twice as

Discrimination



58% of disabled people have felt at risk of losing their job because of their impairment or condition



53% of disabled people have experienced bullying or harassment at work

Employment

1 in 8 disabled people have been overlooked for promotion at work

1 in 4 disabled people say their employer is not supportive of their disability or condition

1 in 5 disabled employees are aware of their employment rights



Attitudes
